

Information for authors

1. The collection of scientific articles is a peer-reviewed periodical "Studies in a Changing Business Environment" ISSN 2029-2805 (print), ISSN 2029-2813 (online), published every two years and included in the Index Copernicus database.

The deadline for submitting the full paper is **11 February 2019 by e-mail info@leda.lt**

2. The article is reviewed by one scientist chosen by the author(s) as well as by a member of the scientific committee of the conference.
3. The text of the article is not editable. Pay attention to the language of the article.

Required structure of article:

- annotation;
 - introduction;
 - relevance of the topic;
 - research problem;
 - the purpose and tasks of the article;
 - research object;
 - methodology of research;
 - main chapters (2-4);
 - theoretical justification of the research
 - research results and their analysis;
 - conclusions;
 - list of references;
 - summary in Lithuanian.
4. The article should **not exceed 6 pages** in Lithuanian or English, in A4 format, MC Word, Times New Roman
 5. Article margins: Top – 2,0 cm, Bottom – 2,0 cm, Left – 2,0 cm; Right - 2,0 cm, 1,27 cm - First Line Indentation
 6. The beginning of the article should be indicated:
 - 6.1. title of the article: All caps, Centered, **Bold 14** pt, single line spacing.
 - 6.2. author(s) name(s), surname(s): Centered, **Bold, Italic 12** pt.
 - 6.3. institution: Centered, *Italic*, 10 pt.;
 - 6.4. annotation – **annotation**, 11pt Bolt, text - 9 pt, Centered;
 - 6.5. key words: – Normal, 9 pt
 7. Main body text: Normal, 10 pt, Single line spacing. Titles of the chapters: Normal 11 pt, All caps, Centered.
 8. **List of references** (not numbered). All references should be listed at the end of the paper in alphabetical order, 9 pt. Each source information is provided in the following order (**see Annex 4**)
 - 8.1. serial number;
 - 8.2. author's surname, the first letter of the name (if there are several authors, they are given by semicolons);
 - 8.3. title of source, Normal, 9 pt;
 - 8.4. title of the publication and the publishing house, *Italic*, 9 pt;
 - 8.5. date, volume number, publication number (ISBN, ISSN), page numbers, Normal, 9 pt
 9. The formulas are written using the standard Word formula editor, the size of the main variables (Size Full) - 10pt (variables and their indexes, except for of numbers, *Italic*).
 10. Table numbers and titles are written above the tables. The tables are numbered as follows: Table 1, Table 2, etc. (10 pt. Bold). In the same line is the name of the table (10 pt, *Italic*). Everything is aligned to the left edge of the Left. For example: **Table 1. Comparison of initial data and results**
 11. Illustrations (figures) are placed directly into the text (without frames). The names of the pictures are written after the figure in 10 pt. The figures are numbered as follows: Figure 1, Figure 2, ... Bold). For example: **Figure 1. Comparative Statics Model** This is followed by an Italic font. Everything is centered. Illustrations need to be inserted into the text not as pictures, but as simple charts for adjusting.
 12. **Summary** (in Lithuanian, not numbered). Title - (Bold, Centered, all caps, 11pt), text – normal, 9 pt, Single line spacing.
